Guidebook for services

This guidebook was developed collaboratively by professionals from various countries involved in this project. It provides a comprehensive overview of services available to support individuals with autism, offering them a clear understanding of the resources they can access in their respective regions. The services are categorized according to key areas of the Quality of Life Measure (Schalock & Verdugo, 2002), and expanded to include essential domains, such as:



Mental Health: Services offering psychological and emotional support, including counseling, therapy, and crisis intervention.



Education: Resources that focus on academic support, specialized learning programs, and inclusive education for individuals with autism.



Health: Access to medical services, therapies, and healthcare initiatives tailored to the specific needs of individuals with autism.



Culture and Leisure: Opportunities for creative expression, participation in the arts, and access to leisure activities that promote well-being.



Sports: Programs and services that encourage physical activity, teamwork, and fitness through accessible sports opportunities.



NGOs/Volunteering: Information on non-profit organizations and volunteering opportunities that contribute to community involvement and social engagement.




Employment: Support services that assist with job training, workplace inclusion, and career opportunities for individuals on the autism spectrum.

CRPD

Description/Role of service:

In Malta, the Commission for the Rights of Persons with Disability (CRPD) serves as the national authority to protect and promote the rights of people with disabilities, aligned with the UN Convention on the Rights of Persons with Disabilities (UNCRPD). Established in accordance with Malta's obligations under the UNCRPD, CRPD monitors and enforces laws against discrimination, working to ensure full accessibility and equal opportunities for people with disabilities in public and private sectors.

CRPD's initiatives range from advocacy and raising public awareness to direct intervention when discrimination cases are reported. In 2021, a public consultation process was launched for new legislation that strengthens CRPD's power, particularly in compliance and enforcement, to address disability-related discrimination and improve access to justice for people with disabilities. The organization also plays a role in drafting national policy that includes measures for better workplace integration, education accessibility, and social inclusion.


Description/Role of service:

EARLY INTERVENTION SERVICE

AREA: Education

NAME OF SERVICE:

Early intervention unit

Description/Role of service:

Malta's Early Intervention Unit offers specialized support for young children (ages 0-5) with developmental delays or disabilities, focusing on minimizing delays and enhancing skill development. This service is family-centered, involving parents in therapy and support planning, often integrating assessments and early treatment to support the child's physical, cognitive, and social progress. The service is coordinated by Malta's Ministry of Education and Agenzija Sapport, ensuring accessible, tailored support to empower families and improve the child's long-term developmental outcomes.

Youth.inc - Agenzija Zgħazagħ

Description/Role of service:

Youth.inc, managed by Malta's national youth agency, Aġenzija Żgħażagħ, is an inclusive education and skill-building program for young people aged 16 to 21. It is tailored for those who have completed compulsory schooling but may lack the qualifications for post-secondary education or are not in steady employment. The program uses applied, non-formal learning methods, helping participants develop essential skills in communication, critical thinking, and practical workplace competences. It is structured around Malta's Qualifications Framework, offering levels 1 through 3 in vocational training that can lead to further educational opportunities or employment readiness.

Youth.inc also includes a Youth Council that allows participants to engage in community-building activities, enhancing their social skills and promoting teamwork through initiatives like fundraising events and social projects. The program thus provides a well-rounded developmental experience aimed at improving both professional and personal growth for Maltese youth.

Description/Role of service:

The Child Development Assessment Unit (CDAU) in Malta, provides specialized support and assessments for children with developmental challenges. It serves children with conditions such as autism, ADHD, cerebral palsy, Down syndrome, and learning difficulties. CDAU's multidisciplinary team includes professionals like pediatricians, speech and language therapists, occupational therapists, psychologists, and physiotherapists. These experts offer both individual and group therapies tailored to each child.

Sensability Scheme

Description/Role of service:

The SensAbility Scheme in Malta, managed by the Housing Authority, provides up to €6,000 in financial assistance to help families create a sensory room for individuals with sensory processing challenges, primarily those with autism, ADHD, and Down syndrome. The scheme covers the cost of sensory equipment, which includes items designed to aid relaxation, focus, and the regulation of sensory input. These rooms, featuring lights, colors, sounds, and other stimuli, are intended to create a therapeutic environment that supports individuals in managing sensory overload and developing social and motor skills. An occupational therapist assesses and recommends specific adaptations. Families can apply for the scheme directly through the Housing Authority or through Servizz.gov



Psychiatric Hospital Attica "Dromokaiteio"

Description/Role of service:

Dromokaiteio (sometimes also Dromokaiteio Therapetirio) is a specialized hospital psychiatric unit for adults with psychiatric disorders, intellectual challenges, and autistic people. It consists of Regular Outpatient Clinics, an On-call – Emergency Department, a Psychotherapy Center, and a Mental Health Centre. Dromokaiteio also has 3 Psychiatric Departments, which consist of 8 departments of chronic hospitalization, of medium hospitalization, and of short-term hospitalization.

NAME OF SERVICE:

The psychiatric department of Sismanoglio (General Hospital of Attica)

Description/Role of service:

The Mental Health Department of the Sismanoglio Hospital consists of 2 Departments, one for adults and one for children/adolescents. It is an open psychiatric department whose main objective is outpatient monitoring and short inpatient hospitalization. It is based on modern psychiatric thinking of the biopsychosocial therapeutic approach of psychiatric patients, with respect for their dignity and human rights. It contributes to the avoidance of the social stigma of mental illness and the psychiatrization of psychosocial problems, the reduction of psychiatric hospitalization, and the avoidance of cutting off the patient from his environment. It has 4 Decentralized Structures. One is a hostel of adults, which is a psychosocial rehabilitation housing structure for people with chronic mental illnesses. Their goal is to provide comprehensive treatment so that after a period of time, the guests can achieve as much independent living in the community as possible. The youth hostels are open community psychosocial rehabilitation structures. In the Simanoglio Department belongs the Community Center for Child & Adolescent Mental Health (Ko. K.P.Y.P.E.) of Pallini, which aim is to assess and treat developmental, psychological and psychiatric disorders. The Department also has the Eating Disorder Unit for adolescents and youth (16-22 years old), which aims at outpatient treatment, but also, someone can be hospitalized if needed. At last, educational programs are drawn up which are attended by all members of the Department of Psychiatry for adults and children/adolescents and aim at the ongoing education of permanent staff and trainees.

The Psychiatric Department of Eginitio Hospital

Description/Role of service:

The Eginitio Hospital was founded in 1904 and housed its headquarters of Neurology and Psychiatry of the National and Kapodistrian University of Athens (EKPA). The Psychiatry Department treats only adults with psychiatric disorders, intellectual challenges, and autistic people. It consists of inpatient departments and outpatient clinics. It has a community mental health center (Byrona-Kaesariani) and other community services such as daycare centers and centers for vocational/prevocational and psychosocial rehabilitation. There are also post-hospital hotels, supervised apartments and a unit for additional treatment. Also, the University Institute of Mental Health (E.P.I.PS.Y.) is part of the department that aims to research and educate mental health professionals.

NAME OF SERVICE:

The Psychiatric Department of "Attikon" University General Hospital

Description/Role of service:

The 2nd Psychiatric Clinic of the National and Kapodistrian University of Athens was established and started operating at the "Attikon" in 2003, which provides for the operation of clinical departments, intermediate structures of psychiatric care, and units of research and educational activities. The clinic consists of a Nursing Department, Regular Outpatient Clinics, Special Outpatient Clinics, such as Psychiatry, Interdisciplinary Psychiatry, Psychogeriatrics, Preventive Psychiatry and Mental Health Promotion, Emotional Disorders and Self-destructive Behavior, Eating Disorders, Alcoholism and Other Substance Addictions, Child Psychiatric Clinic, Administration of long-acting antipsychotics, and Group Psychoeducation of Bipolar Patients. According to the NHS on-call schedule, the Psychiatric Clinic is also on call for emergencies. It provides training for mental health professionals.

NAME OF SERVICE:

Unified Special Vocational Gymnasiums - High Schools (ENEGYL)

Description/Role of service:

"The school, which belongs to the Secondary Special Vocational Education, is addressed to students with learning difficulties, which cannot be effectively addressed in the usual educational structures. In order for a student to attend the Unified Special Vocational Gymnasium – Lyceum, he/she needs to have received an opinion from the Center for Educational and Counseling Support (K.E.D.A.S.Y.), of the respective prefecture, in which proposed this educational framework as the most appropriate for their learning and emotional support. Autistic adolescents can enroll up to the age of 16 in the Unified Special Vocational Gymnasium in their region. The staff of the school consists of:

- a. Special education teachers who implement differentiated teaching programs so that students with learning difficulties can easily assimilate the official curriculum.
- b. A psychologist specializing in school psychology or special education who provides systematic psychological support to each student individually within school hours.
- c. Social worker who actively supports students' families and makes the necessary connections with social services and agencies to facilitate the social integration of students.
- d. Speech therapist, who deals with the prevention, evaluation, and treatment of speech, voice, speech, chewing, and swallowing disorders in children and adults, whatever the cause of these disorders: neurological, developmental, or functional.

The distribution of pupils in school classes is not done according to the usual alphabetical order but takes into account the particularities and capabilities of pupils so that differentiated teaching can be implemented. Each class of the Unified Special Vocational Gymnasium – Lyceum can be attended by 5 (minimum) to 10 students (maximum) so that the implementation of individualized education programs is possible. The Special Vocational Lower Secondary School



implements the official curriculum of general education lower secondary schools but offers students with disabilities and special educational needs the opportunity to complete compulsory education (by awarding a high school leaving certificate) through teaching practices tailored to their needs.



NAME OF SERVICE:

Special Vocational Education Laboratories (EEEEK)

Description/Role of service:

"The Special Vocational Education Laboratories (EEEEK) are public schools of Special Education, under the Directorate of Secondary Education. They are aimed at students with high support needs, which are the result of:

- a. specific disability (intellectual and learning challenges),
- b. multiple disabilities (intellectual disability and severe vision and hearing impairment, intellectual disability and autism, etc.),
- c. complex cognitive, emotional, and social difficulties certified by KEDASY or recognized medical-pedagogical services. (Law 3699-08 Special Education, Government Gazette 199 vol. A' 2-10-08)

EEEEK implements specially adapted and personalized supportive educational programs that serve the following objectives:

- Basic academic and social skills.
- Practical vocational education commensurate with the skills and competences.
- The provision of pre-vocational education so that students with appropriate help and support can actively participate in economic and social life.

Social skills development of people Practicing self-care, personal care, and leisure time management skills.. Students can enroll after completing primary education in the EEEEK of their region.

NAME OF SERVICE:

Special Primary School of Piraeus for Autistic Children

Description/Role of service:

The Special Primary School of Piraeus for Children with Autism falls under the Directorate of Primary Education. The educational and psychosocial needs of students are covered by an equal number of special education teachers and specialised special educational staff (gymnast, social worker, psychologist, occupational therapist, school nurse, speech therapist and special auxiliary staff). The complexity of special educational needs creates an urgent need for interdisciplinary, multifaceted support and individualized approaches to students. Students can enroll after completing mandatory preschool education, provided they have been diagnosed with autism.

NAME OF SERVICE:

School of Higher Vocational Training for persons with disabilities

Description/Role of service:

"These are secondary education schools for persons who have completed their High School Education and have a valid certification of disability. They provide adapted education in several specializations. Unfortunately, the classes are not specifically adapted to the needs of neurodivergent individuals. The exhibition, which includes mainly works of sculpture and ceramics, of burial nature in their majority, is arranged – in chronological sections. The Greek Ephorate of Antiquities of Athens has contributed to the development of accessibility guidelines for autistic individuals (social stories in Greek and English).
